WHERE TO HIDE THE CLUES

1. You will not hide the first clue. You will hand it to your child to begin the treasure hunt.
2. Place the second clue in the pantry or in the refrigerator (depending on your child's favorite food). For younger children, attach the clue to the outside of the pantry or refrigerator door.
3. Place the clue under your child's pillow or comforter (or on the bed or pillow for younger children).
4. Place on or near your child's bicycle or helmet.
5. Hide this clue under your welcome mat. For younger children, leave it on top of the welcome mat or attach to the front door.
6. Hide it in the mailbox if it isn't a mail day or if your mail carrier has already come for the day. Otherwise, attach to the back of your mailbox.
7. Place inside a book your child is currently reading. For younger children, leave the clue sticking up out the top so it is easily visible.
8. Hide in your child's bathroom, preferably in the tub/shower or in the sink.
9. Place this clue underneath the couch cushion. For younger children, leave it on the seat.
10. Tape this clue to the back of any door in the house.

Hide the "treasure" in the dryer.
