

Amusement Park Checklist

Do Your Homework

- Search online for discounts (theme park site, Groupon, RetailMeNot, travel sites)
- Purchase and print tickets
- Check park policies (hours, food restrictions, height/age requirements for rides)
- Check the weather report for the day of visit
- Download park app to all smartphones if available

Get Ready

- Make pet care arrangements
- Leave house keys and your contact information with a trusted neighbor
- Charge cell phones and camera batteries (if applicable)

Final Checklist Before You Leave

- Make sure everyone is wearing comfortable shoes
- If you will be visiting a park with a water park/water rides, make sure you have towels, flip flops, swimsuits, cover ups, and a change of clothes/shoes
- Prepare for a sunny day with sunglasses, sunscreen, and hats
- Be prepared for rain with rain slickers and a change of clothes
- Bring cash for games, food, and parking
- Make sure you have enough water for everyone
- Pack food, snacks, cooler
- Backpack(s) to carry everything
- Bring cell phones and chargers
- Double check that you have the tickets
- Turn on porch lights or set timers so you don't come home to a dark house



At the Park

- Write down or take a picture of your parking area
- Review with everyone instructions and timeline for meeting up, eating, finding one another
- Have a park employee take your group picture right away so you have at least one photo with everyone in it
- Get wristbands for the kids to indicate their height to avoid being measured at each ride
